Some parents may know me well, while others might be hearing my name for the first time. Thomas Jefferson is a great school with wonderful teachers, special area professionals, and support staff. Many of these incredible items are on loan from other museums and private collectors. There is a children's play area called [Mrs. Lincoln's Attic](#). Here children can dress up in replica clothes from Lincoln's time and play games from the time period. Finally, the museum has a great bookstore and gift shop. There's plenty to buy here, but you could spend lots of money. So, I hope I have piqued your interest in this great museum. Abraham Lincoln is from our state; he's our president. Take a weekend and visit Springfield. Enjoy the new Lincoln Museum and all the Lincoln sites. I guarantee...it's worth it!
